

**ANNEX A**  
**2012 CAF FELLOWSHIP**  
**APPLICATION FORMAT**

There are two parts of an application for the CAF Fellowship in 2012. Part 1 contains the personal details and Part 2 is an outline of the thesis proposed as part of the CAF Fellowship. The requirements for each part are detailed below.

**PART 1 – PERSONAL DETAIL**

1. Submission of a Form PE 57 – Standard Application is required with additional attachments, if applicable:
  - a. Career development statement – A statement as to how the attainment of an MPhil will assist you in your RAAF career, and hence the RAAF.
  - b. Military record – include a summary of your career with emphasis on postings, courses, and operational deployment history. An indication of future goals/posting/career preferences is also required.
  - c. Academic record – include highest education level attained together with specific details about any relevant tertiary level course/s undertaken.
  - d. Published works – include a list of any published works and indicate those that were refereed works.

**PART 2 – THESIS PROPOSAL**

2. The submission of the research proposal enables the interview panel to review each application on its merits prior to the final interview being undertaken. Completion of the application requires:
  - a. Provisional title of thesis.
  - b. A synopsis of approx 500 words which contains the objectives of the thesis, its relevance to air power, the benefit to Air Force and an outline of the proposed research project.
